ABSTRACT:

This presentation will cover four projects and about 8 miles of NYC’s waterfront: Hudson River Park, East River Waterfront, Pier A and Hunter’s Point. It will highlight some of the challenges of waterfront planning, design and construction, including: dealing with historic conditions; issues of resilience and longevity in the harsh waterfront conditions; variable geotechnical conditions; the technical challenges of pier design; and piling in the poor ground conditions of the Hudson River.
